NATIONAL PAY AND PENSIONS CAMPAIGN Zoom Meetings for Branch Activists

Zoom meetings arranged for HMRC activists for 10/11 February 2022

Activists' meetings

PCS Revenue and Customs Group are arranging two Zoom meetings, to allow PCS activists within HMRC to be updated on the union's national pay and pensions campaign.

Although this June will see the beginning of the final year of HMRC's three-year pay deal, and although our increases have been above those seen across the rest of Whitehall, the current cost of living is outstripping even our pay award for 2022/23; and that's without the planned increase in National Insurance contributions set for April and the widely anticipated hike in energy prices set for the same month. Additionally, the current deal comes on the back of a decade of real-term pay-cuts and there is no guarantee of any further increases after this deal expires.

All-in-all, it makes perfect sense for HMRC members to send the strongest possible signal to the government.
