# RE-RUN OF GROUP EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELECTION Make sure you cast your vote

- Closing date for Group Executive Committee election is Noon on Tuesday 7 June
  - Make sure you vote in the re-run ballot
  - Urgent action needed if you need a replacement ballot paper

This briefing reminds all members in HMRC that there is still time to vote in the re-run election for some positions in the Group Executive Committee (GEC).

### Closing date for voting in the re-run election

The re-run election will close at **12:00 noon on Tuesday 7 June 2022**. Votes received after this deadline will not be counted.

Where PCS holds a personal email address for you, then you will have received an electronic ballot paper. Where we don't hold a personal email address for you, then you'll have received a ballot paper through the post (although this postal ballot paper also provides you with a code, so you can still vote electronically if you choose).

#### Make sure you vote

PCS takes our democratic responsibilities most seriously, hence the need to re-run this ballot and to ensure that everyone has an equal opportunity to get involved in their union.

As members in HMRC, it is your vote that decides who leads PCS in the department over the next year, so it is vital that you make sure you exercise that vote in the re-run ballot.

The re-run Group Executive Committee ballot opened on 18 May 2022, and your re-run election email/ballot will be dated accordingly. For your vote to count, you will need to make sure you vote in the re-run ballot.

#### Replacement ballot papers: Urgent action needed

All members should have received their ballot paper by now. If you require a replacement ballot paper you should urgently email <a href="mailto:balloting@pcs.org.uk">balloting@pcs.org.uk</a>, providing your <a href="mailto:personal email address">personal email address</a> <a href="mailto:and-either-your PCS">and</a> either your <a href="mailto:personal-email address">PCS</a> <a href="mailto:personal-emailto:pe

Given that there are two days of Public Holidays between now and the closing date, please make every effort to request your replacement ballot by no later than **5:00pm on Tuesday 31 May 2022**.
